BRIDGE STREET HISTORY CENTER PLANS EXCITING 2026

The year begins with a premiere event on Friday, February 13, at the Hood County Courthouse, honoring its architect, Wesley Clark Dodson. The Bridge Street History Center follows up with a stellar lineup of programming during the coming year. In March, at the Hood County Courthouse, BSHC will host the installation and unveiling of the marker commemorating the designation of the

Granbury Historic District as a National Historic Place. In the spring, the BSHC will reopen for the year with new displays focusing on even more Hood County stories of the past. On April 30, the BSHC will host a play based on the life of Granbury historian and entrepreneur, Mary Lou Watkins. In November, the year finishes with the Ramay-Macatee Lecture Series at Granbury Live.
